Our Philosophy, Purpose & Overview

Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School is a ministry of Jesus Christ, who is the foundation of all that we do. We partner with churches and families to provide an excellent Christian education through which students actively participate in curricular and extra-curricular endeavors, allowing them to discover and enhance their unique, God-given spiritual, intellectual, physical, and personal gifts and abilities.

CORLHS sets up students for post-high school education and career success by establishing high expectations in learning and conduct while providing the support and attention students need to attain these demanding standards. This prepares students to face the challenges that lie ahead and leads them to become productive, responsible members of society and the church.

At the time in their lives when teenagers face the greatest temptation to make unhealthy life decisions, CORLHS surrounds students with positive influences in a drug-free, family-oriented atmosphere. This nurturing and secure setting allows students to be themselves, develop in integrity, and establish life-long friendships and constructive mentor relationships.

Christ Our Rock is open to all families in our community, providing an educational alternative while sharing with them the Gospel of Jesus Christ. CORLHS embraces the core values of service, honesty, unconditional love, respect, encouragement, and reverence for God.

About 50% of our students are members of a Lutheran congregation. Other families come from a variety of Christian denominations, while some students have no church home. Over 30 different Christian congregations are represented in the CORLHS student body.

The policies of CORLHS have been crafted to promote a caring, Christian atmosphere. The Code of Christian Conduct focuses on treating others with brotherly love, presented through three principles: be respectful, be restrained, and be responsible. Discipline procedures have also been designed to lead students through a process of confession, repentance, and forgiveness. Biblical examples and discussion of God's love and will for us permeates the entire curriculum.

CORLHS is recognized by the Illinois State Board of Education and is accredited by National Lutheran School Accreditation and AdvancED.

Admissions Policy

Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School has been established to serve young people in the Mid-Kaskaskia River Valley. Campus

Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School is located on a 41 acre campus approximately four miles northwest of Centralia. The campus, located on Shattuc Road near Kaskaskia College, features a 24,600 sq. ft. facility (completed in April, 2007) that includes a media center, science lab, art room, music room, gymnasium, five general classrooms, commons, offices, locker rooms and prayer chapel. The campus includes soccer and baseball fields and has plenty of space for future expansion. Its proximity to Kaskaskia College makes it possible for a close relationship to exist between the two schools, including a dual enrollment program.

Extra-Curricular Programs

Christ Our Rock Lutheran High School recognizes the importance of extra-curricular programs in the development of well-rounded individuals. The CORLHS extra-curricular programs can be divided into four categories: athletics, fine arts, academic, and service and leadership.

CORLHS is committed to serving students that have interests in these areas. Because of our small environment, students will have many opportunities to participate in the extra-curricular programs, and are encouraged to do so.
